- 1. Nomination Letter (minimal requirements listed below; 2-page limit)
 - Synopsis of nominee's professional merits and work history
 - Relationship of nominator to nominee (e.g., member of department, chair of department, professional colleague...)
 - Statement of the nominee's professional contributions and achievements related to the field of plant breeding (innovative techniques, variety and germplasm developments, impact within industry)
 - Contact information of nominator and nominee

2. Curriculum Vitae (minimal requirements listed below)

- Name, title, employer, work address
- Professional preparation Degrees, institutions, and dates
- Professional history Job titles, employers, places, and dates
- Grants. Awards and Honors
- Publications (Include all relevant refereed and non-refereed publications as well as patents, PVP's, and cultivar and germplasm releases.)

3. Letters of Support

It is suggested that each nomination be accompanied by 2 to 5 signed letters of support submitted as PDF files, 1-2 pages each. Each letter should include the author's email address and telephone number.

POST-AWARD EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. <u>After</u> being notified that the nominee has been selected for the award, the award recipient should submit the following. These items will used at the annual meeting, for press releases and announcements.
