Position Title: PhD Student in Soybean Plant Breeding

Institution: North Dakota State University (NDSU)

About the Position:

North Dakota State University (NDSU) is seeking a highly motivated PhD student to join the NDSU Soybean Breeding and Genetics program. The selected candidate will earn a PhD from NDSU while focusing on impactful research and contributing to the advancement of the breeding program. This is a fully funded position offering an annual stipend of \$30,000 and student health insurance, with funding for 4-5 years.

Responsibilities:

- Conduct and maintain an iron deficiency chlorosis (IDC) study.
- Develop and execute an additional dissertation research project independently.
- Assist with day-to-day operations of the breeding program, including fieldwork and data collection.

Required Qualifications:

- A master's degree in plant Breeding, Genetics, Physiology, or another agricultural science.
- Ability to obtain a valid United States driver's license.
- Familiarity with R programming and Linux systems.

Preferred Qualifications:

- Experience in the American agricultural industry.
- A bachelor's or master's degree in plant Breeding, Genetics, Physiology, or another agricultural science from an American institution.
- A valid United States driver's license at the time of application.

Compensation:

- Annual stipend of \$30,000.
- Student health insurance.
- 4-5 years of PhD funding.
